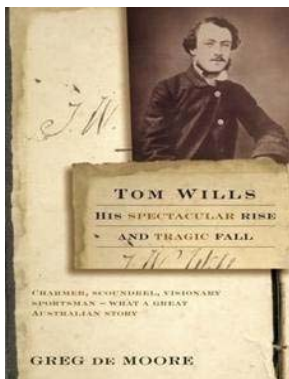
MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT OWCA

The Fourteenth Edition of the Wesley College Song Book was officially launched at a celebratory concert held on Sunday 19 July at the Melbourne Recital Centre.

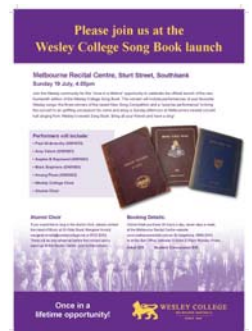
This latest edition has 43 songs including three Cato songs; *Star*, *Traditions* and *United and Strong*.

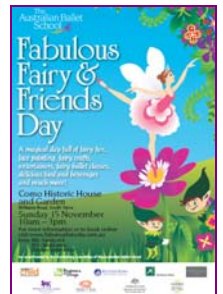
